### **Updated COVID-19 requirements for NSW team members**

# What is changing for authorised workers in NSW?

Some key changes will come into effect that impact our Linfox and BevChain team members in NSW.



## What is changing?

Authorised workers who leave or enter a Local Government Area (LGA) of concern are now legally required to obtain a **travel registration** permit.



- have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- have a booking to get a COVID-19 vaccination on or before 19 September or
- hold and carry an exemption for medical reasons, to obtain a travel registration.

#### From Monday 20 September 2021, authorised workers MUST:

- have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- hold and carry an exemption for medical reasons, to obtain a travel registration.

## Who needs to register travel in NSW?

The NSW Government requires the following team members to hold a **travel registration** permit:

- Those who live in a Local Government Area (LGA)
  of concern and need to leave it for work, including
  going to another LGA of concern (authorised
  workers), and
- Those who enter an LGA of concern for work, but don't live in one (permitted workers).
- Those from a non-LGA of concern and you need to travel more than 50km outside of Greater Sydney for work (also known as 'regional permit').



Note: Greater Sydney does not include Shellharbour and the Central Coast for the purposes of this travel registration.

## How do I complete my travel registration?

To **register** your travel, go to the **Service NSW website** (see link below) and complete the following steps.

- 1. Verify you meet the eligibility requirements
- **2. Select** the 'Register online' button
- 3. Log in, or create your MyService NSW Account
- **4. Follow** the prompts to complete your registration
- 5. Check that you have received your travel registration by email.

#### Important tip for drivers

For authorised workers (drivers) planning to visit multiple work-related addresses that may not be known prior to completing the travel registration permit, it's recommended that you select 'Authorised worker with unknown work addresses' as your 'Reason for Travel'.

For those who know all their work-related addresses when completing the travel registration permit, you should select 'Authorised worker' and then enter each address as required.

## Do I need to be vaccinated or tested?

From Thursday 9 September 2021 there are vaccination requirements for team members who live in an LGA of concern and need to leave for work.

To obtain a travel registration permit, these authorised workers must also have:

- At least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- A booking to get a COVID-19 vaccination on or before 19 September or
- An exemption for medical reasons (Medical Contraindication Form).

From **Monday 20 September**, to obtain a travel registration permit, these authorised workers must also have:

- At least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- An exemption for medical reasons (medical contraindication form).

Permitted workers who do not live in an LGA of concern but enter one for work will require a travel registration permit but are not subject to the above vaccination requirements.



Testing is not an alternative to vaccination.

Those living in Greater Sydney (inc. Blue Mountains and Wollongong) and who travel 50km or more outside of Greater Sydney, the requirement to **get tested every 7 days** remains the same.

## What do I need to carry with me when I travel?

If you leave or enter one of the NSW LGAs of concern you MUST be able to show both your:

1. COVID-19 travel registration, and

#### 2. Authorised Worker Letter

**From Thursday 9 September 2021**, you should also be prepared to **show evidence** that you have either:

- Received at least 1 dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- Booked a COVID-19 vaccination appointment on or before 19 September or
- Obtained a COVID-19 Medical Contraindication Form (filled out by a medical practitioner if you
  have a medical reason not to get vaccinated)

From Monday 20 September 2021, you should be prepared to show evidence that you have either:

- Received at least 1 dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or
- Obtained a COVID-19 Medical Contraindication Form (filled out by a medical practitioner if you
  have a medical reason not to get vaccinated)



# How to show evidence you have a medical reason NOT to get vaccinated



If you have a medical reason why you can't be vaccinated, you must obtain and carry a valid **COVID-19 Medical Contraindication Form.** 

This must be completed by a medical practitioner, such as your doctor.

You may be required to **produce this as evidence**, so keep a copy of this form with you at all times.

## How to show evidence you have had a COVID-19 test



For those who are getting a COVID-19 test, you **must carry proof** of your test which can include:

- SMS text message on your phone
- Email confirmation of your test and/or test results

You may be asked to **show proof** of your test when you:

Arrive at work

or

When requested by a police officer.
